

Follow these steps to set up your dial up settings on Windows 2000:

1. In the start menu click settings → network and dial-up connections
2. In the new window double click make a new connection
3. You will be welcomed to the Network Connection Wizard, click next
4. Select Dial-Up to the Internet and click next
5. Select I want to set up my Internet connection manually, or I want to connect through a local area network (LAN) and click next
6. Make sure I connect through a phone line and a modem is selected and click next
7. Enter the dial up number supplied to you when you signed up and click next
8. Enter your username followed by @netastic (i.e. [user@netastic](#))
9. Enter your password supplied to you and click next
10. Enter Netastic as your Connection name and click next
11. Select No and click next
12. Click Finish

To Connect to the Internet:

1. In the start menu click settings → network and dial-up connections
2. Double click the Netastic icon
3. The computer will dial and then minimize the dial information into an icon of 2 computers in the bottom right next to your clock
4. To disconnect from the internet right-click the 2 computers and select disconnect
