

Follow these steps to set up your dial up settings on Windows XP:

1. In the start menu click the control panel
2. If your window says Pick a Category then Click Network and Internet connections otherwise double click Network connections and skip to step 4
3. Click Network Connections
4. On the left click Create a new connection
5. Click Next
6. Make sure Connect to the internet is selected and click next
7. Select Set up my connection manually and click next
8. Make sure Connect using a dial-up modem is selected and click next
9. Enter Netastic as your ISP name and click next
10. Enter the dial up number supplied to you when you signed up and click next
11. Enter your username followed by @netastic (i.e. [user@netastic](#))
12. Enter the password supplied to you twice and click next
13. Select add this connection to my desktop and click finish

To connect to the Internet:

1. Double click the Netastic Icon on your desktop
2. In the window that comes up click dial
3. The computer will dial up and then minimize the dial information into an icon of 2 computers in the bottom right next to your clock
4. To disconnect from the internet right-click the 2 computers and select disconnect
